

1 Create a scented pottery piece! Make your own aroma stone

Add a few drops of essential oils, a piece of pottery emitting a pleasant fragrance can improve your home environment. Many look for a way to relax when they spend lots of time at home. In this event you will make your own unglazed aroma stone. Let your imagination play as you knead the clay, wondering how to shape it.

Make 1-5 aroma stones (depending on size) from 200g of clay. We also have a course including funch and essential oils.

Notes

★ Course with lunch at "Ishigama Pizza Moon" (+¥1,500) ★ Course includes one bottle of naturally grown hinoki cypress essential oil (+¥1,600) ★ Course includes material for making 1-5 pieces (depending on size)

Examples: 1 ornament or 1 to 3 objects or 5 cookie-shaped pieces. ★ The finished product we deliver will be unglazed pottery. Please note that unglazed pottery cracks more easily and chips are more likely to occur compared to other pottery.

★ The oil may cause stains. ★ Your pieces will be finished and handed over approximately one month after the event.

We will contact you by phone as soon as the product is finished. ★ Delivery You may pick up your work at the museum, or we will ship it to you (shipping fee approx. ¥1,100). ★ Dress Please come in clothes that can be soiled, or bring your apron.

Make a ceramic house-shaped candle cover to serve as a delightful daytime decoration, and relax your mind with it's soft flickering light at night. Starting with a cylindrical clay you'il carve out windows and doors and paste a roof and chimney. Never tried pottery before? No need to worry! We'll help you whenever you need it. you'll also be able to enjoy lunch at the "Ishigama (Stone Kiln) Pizza Moon" restaurant. This course costs an additional ¥1,500.

- ★ The course includes one house-shaped candle cover ★ You will choose between one of three types of shaped clay:
- Square pillar 1 (8 cm length x 8 cm width x 12 cm height) Square pillar 2 (5 cm length x 10 cm width x 12 cm height) Cylinder (9 cm diameter x 12 cm height)
- ★ Ávailable types of glaze Oribe (green) Kuro Oribe (black) Ruri-yu (Ruri glaze) (blue) Blue ash glaze (light blue)
- · Kiseto (ocher) · Ame-yu (brown) · Hai-gusuri (Ash glaze) (transparent)
- ★ Your work will be ready in about 2 months. We will contact you by phone as soon as it is ready.
- ★ Delivery You may pick up your work at the museum, or we will ship it to you (shipping fee approx. ¥1,100).
- * Dress Please come in clothes that can be soiled, or bring your apron.
- ★ Damage You will make a piece of pottery. Please be aware that there is a possibility of damage or breakage due to firing.
