Overview of the 6th Winter School Program

Objectives:

In April 2019, Gifu University launched international Joint Degree Programs (JDP) with both Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati (IITG) and Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM). The Winter School is designed to provide opportunities to students from those institutions who are considering graduate studies a better understanding of Gifu University and Japan. The participants learn Japanese language and culture, visit industry-related companies and facilities, also engage in laboratory work. Gifu University hopes that the participants will serve as a bridge between IITG/UKM and Gifu University, and play a role in fostering mutual understanding for years to come.

The first part of the event was a concert and a lecture about history. In the second part, students had chances to try instruments and costumes.

This excursion was set up for the participants to learn more about Japanese industry and companies. Prior to the excursion, the participants took a special lecture about Japanese industry and companies on December 14 (Wed.). During the Tokyo Excursion, the participants had a chance to visit a major institute, company and government organization in Aichi, Tokyo and Kanagawa for the first time. They took a tour of the Japan Fine Ceramics Center (Aichi), JICA¹⁾ Global Plaza (Tokyo), Sinfonia Technology Co., Ltd. (Tokyo) and Institute of Food Sciences and Technologies, Ajinomoto Co., Inc. Laboratory Experience

December 19 (Mon.)

This experience was set up for the participants to learn more about the soil and ceramics of Japan.

In the first part of the Laboratory Experience, participants took the lecture on the overview of earthen and ceramic wares. In the second part, participants learned about the Scanning Electron Microscope (SEM) and the Energy Dispersive X-ray Spectroscopy (EDX) at Instrumental Analysis Center and experienced the analysis with SEM and EDX.



Off Campus Lecture at Tajimi City

December 21 (Wed)

This Off Campus Lecture was set up for the participants to learn more about Mino ceramic ware, which is one of the famous local industries in Gifu. The participants visited the Mino Ceramic Art Museum, Tajimi (Gifu) and learned about the Mino ware. They had a chance to experience a tea ceremony with using Mino ware. Participants also visited the Kokeigama (potter of Mino ware). After the facility tour, participants tried pottery making. The participants reviewed their Off Campus Lecture on December 22 (Thu.)



Accomplishment Reports and Closing Ceremony

December 26 (Mon.)

On December 26, the final day of Winter School 2022, Accomplishment Reports session was held in Learning Commons 1A and 1B of General Education Building. Dr. YOSHIDA Kazuhiro, President of Gifu University, relevant professors and students joined this session. In just two week-long school activities, the participants did their best and looked confident of their achievements.
